Rules of Entry for Participation in the Festival

1.	<p>Eligibility: Open to all Community Groups. Each community group must submit his/her own application/submission. <u>Booth sharing is not permitted.</u></p>
2.	<p>Location: Located in Guild Park and Gardens, 201 Guildwood Pkwy, Scarborough. Individual site placements will be assigned and sent with notification of your acceptance. *Spaces are 10'x10', Do Not display beyond your allocated space. Community Groups must supply their own tables, chairs, canopy cover, and displays. Display, material to be no higher than 8'</p>
3.	<p><u>VENUE</u></p> <p><i>No hydro is available for vendors</i></p> <p>Hydro and overnight camping are not available at the Guild Park and Gardens.</p> <p>10 x 10 Canopies are required to be secured by <u>weights</u>. <u>No staking on the property.</u></p> <p>Insurance is the responsibility of all community groups! Security will be onsite Friday and Saturday evening; it is recommended that you do not leave items that you do not feel comfortable leaving unattended. It is also requested that all displays are secured with panels or by lowering your canopy in the case of high winds.</p> <p>Dogs must always be on a leash – Area must be kept clean at all times. No Smoking in Park, in Booth area or Food Area.</p>

4.	<p>Parking at Festival</p> <p><u>No cars on the grassed areas, only in designated parking areas assigned by the committee with a parking pass</u></p> <p>The Community Group parking and loading areas will be posted and assigned to load and unload during specific times.</p> <p>Parking will be available -ONE VEHICLE PER BOOTH – NO EXEMPTIONS. <u>PLEASE PRESENT AND POST YOUR PARKING PERMIT UPON ENTRY – ONE VEHICLE PER BOOTH.</u></p>
5.	<p>BOOTH and Vendors</p> <p>Booths are to be ready by no later than 9:45 am on both days. Please come prepared to set up your area – you are responsible to set up your booth – loading and unload</p> <p>Community Groups are responsible for collecting applicable taxes</p> <p>If you would like <u>to reserve your booth location,</u> you may make a request on your application form. All applications are due by June 16, 2023.</p>
6.	<p>Important information:</p> <p>*The Festival Committee or the City of Toronto is not responsible for loss or damage to items left unattended. Private security will be on site on Friday evening from 6:00 p.m. to Saturday morning at 6:00 a.m. and Saturday evening from 6:00 p.m. to Sunday morning at 6:00 a.m. Although security will be on site each artist/vendor is responsible for their own insurance for product, canopy, and set up. You may leave your display and canopy overnight. *City of Toronto Parks Department regulations do not permit vehicles on the show site. All goods must be brought in from the Artist parking area by cart or golf cart (provided by the festival committee) to your space</p>

Golf Carts will be on hand to help you to your designated booth for set up and takedown.
